GETTING TO UA

Airports



[St. Louis Lambert International Airport \(STL\)](#)

About 129 miles from United Alloy or a two hour and 7 mins drive when driving on US-61 N

[Chicago O'Hare \(ORD\)](#)

About 304 miles from United Alloy or a four and a half hour drive when driving on I-88 W, which has tolls

Driving Directions



From the East (I-72 W)

- Traveling west on I-72 W keep left to continue on I-172 N and follow signs for I-172/Quincy
- Take exit 15 toward Columbus Rd/County Rd 1403 N
- Turn left on Columbus Rd/County Rd 1403 N
- Turn right on Cannonball Rd/County Rd 943 E
- Turn left on County Rd 1500 N
- Turn left on Commercial Dr

From the North (US-218 S)

- Traveling south on US-218 S from Iowa City, merge onto IA-27 S/US-218 S/Ave of the Saints
- Stay on IA-27 S then continue onto MO-27 S
- Follow US-61 S/US-24, take exit toward US-24 E/Quincy, merge onto Co Rd 308, then turn left on US-24 E
- Turn right on Bluff Rd
- Turn right on IL-96 N
- Turn right on County Rd 1500N
- Turn right on Commercial Dr

From the South (I-64 W/US-61 N)

- Traveling west on I-64 W/US-40 W from St. Louis take US-61 N
- Turn right to merge onto I-72 E/MO-110/US-36 E then continue to follow I-72E/US-36 E entering Illinois
- Take exit 4 to merge onto I-172 N toward Quincy
- Take exit 15 toward Columbus Rd/County Rd 1403 and turn left
- Turn right on Cannonball Rd/County Rd 943 E
- Turn left on County Rd 1500 N
- Turn left on Commercial Dr

When You Arrive



- Turn into parking lot from Commercial Drive
- Park along the wall of building or in the open space along the property fences
- Do not park in the open lot near the bay door
- Enter at employee entrance and come into the office
- United Alloy requires all visitors to follow all safety protocols

- 1 Wall Parking
- 2 Open Space Parking
- 3 Employee Entrance
- 4 No Parking Permitted



Safety



At United Alloy, safety is our first priority. Please follow these guidelines when visiting our manufacturing facility. (If only attending a meeting, regular office attire is fine.)

The following personal protective equipment is required if your visit will include being on the production floor. If you do not have these items, they will be provided to you.

- Safety glasses
- Steel toed shoes or toe caps
- Hi-Vis Vest
- Shorts, dresses, skirts, open toed shoes, sandals and high heels are not permitted
